- c. Fundraising
- d. Laundry at Friends of the Animals
- e. Fostering animals
- f. Neighborhood homeowner's association events and pools; i.e., Tara, Country Club of Louisiana, etc.
- g. Club sports teams and pools
- h. Any non-SJA summer camp must have written approval from Ms. Spears before a student volunteers. SJA's Sizzling Summer does not need pre-approval.
- i. Open House for students working for bonus points, ambassador points or any other requirement.
- j. Club hours do not rollover to service at any time.
- k. Babysitting
- 1. Any part of the student's own sacramental preparation
- m. Mission trips sponsored by for-profit agencies
