What to do if...

**Absent or late** – contact Ms. McLean, Students' Receptionist

**Appointment during the day** – encourage appointments to be after school or during breaks; however, if students need to leave during the day, they must check out with Ms. McLean before leaving campus

**Absent for several days** – If a student is out for 4 or more days, see their counselor to help make a plan for make-up work/tests.

**Computer crashes** – go to the Help Desk for a loaner

**Completely stressed** – see their counselor

If your daughter chooses a full-credit elective, she will be required to take Summer PE. Information about Summer PE is found in your daughter's acceptance packet.

We recommend 7.0 credits for freshmen, but they may take 6.5 credits. If they enroll in 6.5 credits, then they would have an unstructured/study period for half the year.

### **Portrait of an SJA Honor Student**



- Aligned with standardized tests scores
- Commitment to handling greater amounts of homework
- A's in their classes in middle school
- A love of learning
- If eligible, she may take as many or as few honors classes as she desires

Deciding to take honors? How many? Depends on student's scores, middle school grades, love for learning, commitment to greater amounts of homework, etc.

It's important to remember to have a balance! If not sure, maybe choose to take one or two. What is your daughter involved in outside of school, clubs/organizations, etc.?

### **SJA** Honors Diploma



- 3.8 overall grade point average after 8 semesters of work
- Minimum of I I Honors/Advanced Placement courses over 4 years
- Minimum of 2 Honors/AP classes courses in 9th & 10th grades combined
- Minimum of 2 honors/AP courses in 11th grade
- Among Honors/AP courses in 9th, 10th & 11th grades, 2 must be AP classes
- At least 3 Honors/AP courses must be taken in 12th grade, and 2 must be AP classes
- Must earn all A's & B's in all courses, but can earn I C in Honors/AP Course

Honors and AP classes are assigned an additional QP and are included in the weighted GPA.

Both unweighted and weighted GPA is included on the high school transcript.

1<sup>st</sup> Academics: Must earn a 3.6-5.0 cumulative GPA with no Ds or Fs during 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

They receive a silver SJA medallion and red cord to wear at graduation.

 $2^{nd}$  Academics: Must earn a 3.3-3.599 cumulative GPA with no Ds or Fs during 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

They receive a bronze SJA medallion to wear at graduation.

There are no requirements regarding honors/Advanced Placement courses for the first and second academics.



#### **Semester Grade Calculation**

Ist Quarter Grade = 40%

2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Grade = 40%

Exams = 20%



Quarter grades are not included on the transcript. They are averaged with the midsemester exam to determine the semester grade average.

The quarter grades are numerical; the semester grade is a letter grade.

There are 2 grades posted on the high school transcript per year: First Semester Average and Second Semester Average.


Enter your daughter's ID number and your email address and click submit
